Start here & follow this path.

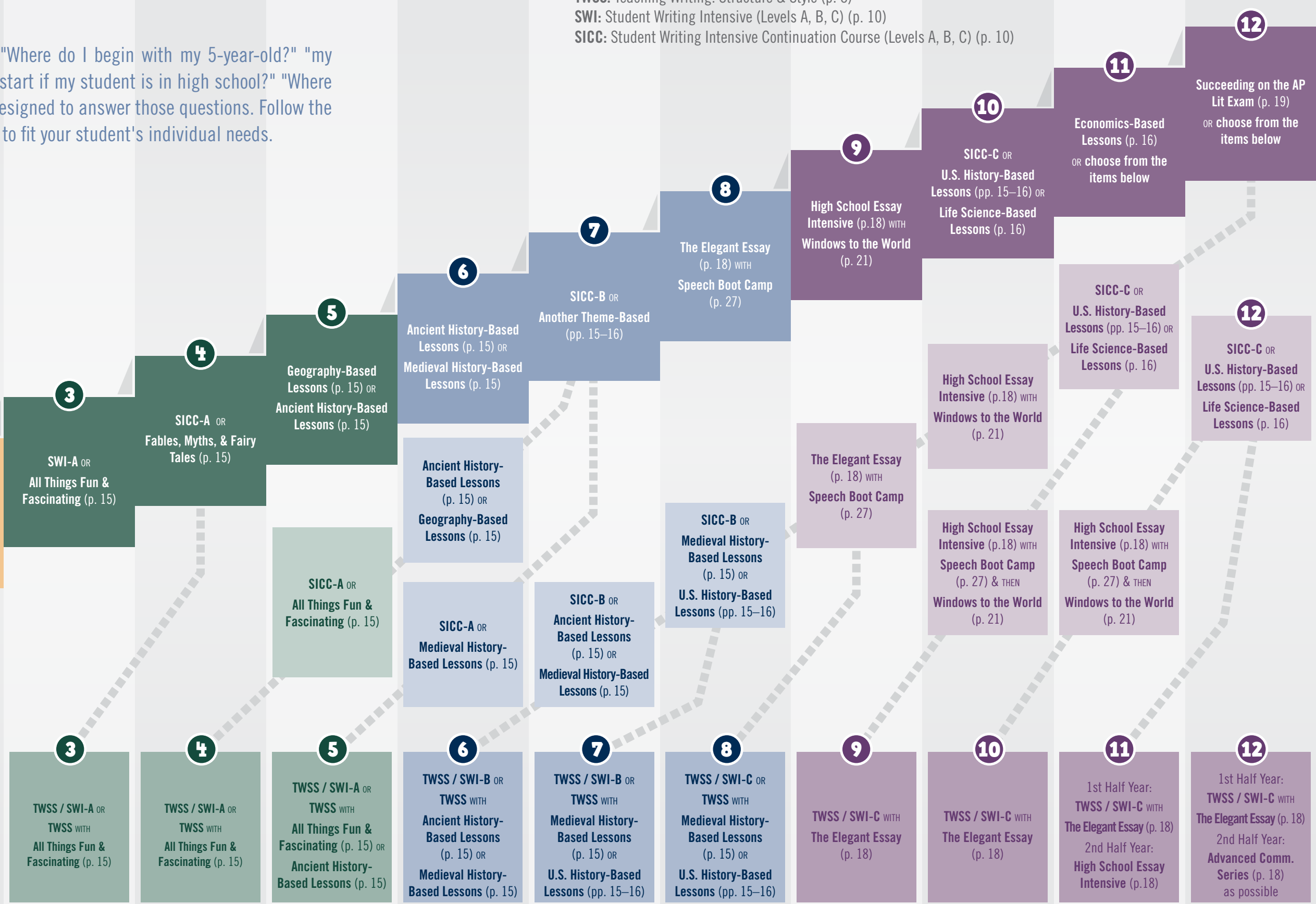
Older children: Find their grade level at the base and follow the path up to the stairway.
